

## Scholarships and Awards for Undergraduate Students

### **Andrew L. “Drew” Wilbert Memorial Award**

Established in 2008, this scholarship recognizes Coastal Environmental Science or Marine Biology majors (juniors or seniors) with a 3.25+ GPA who display environmental awareness, appreciation of nature, and interest in conservation.
